The Town of Pine River accepts recyclables each month at the Town Hall (N1647 Deer Run Avenue, Merrill WI 54452) on the:

Second & Fourth Saturdays, 9:00 AM to Noon

and the

Third Thursdays, 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

The following is a list of what can be dropped off for recycling.

- Glass: clear, brown & green
 (no windows, mirrors, light bulbs or Pyrex cookware)
- Plastic: rinsed milk, soda & detergent bottles and #1 #7 plastic (nothing dirty; no plastic bags of any kind; no plastics that do not hold a shape; no Styrofoam)
- Tin/Steel Cans: from food (no paint cans, aerosol cans or cardboard-sided juice cans)
- Paper Products: newspapers, magazines, books (with hard covers removed), brown grocery bags, paper and flattened cardboard of all kinds (no pizza cardboard, wrapping paper, tissue paper or animal food bags)
- Aluminum: cans & foil only
- Waste Oil: from automotive, motorcycle, lawn & garden equipment & snow-blowers; bring in one-gallon jugs only (no oil filters)

 Note: place oil containers next to the dumpsters.
